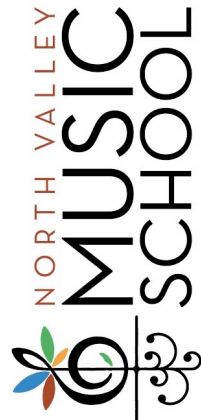
Guest Clinicians

Heidi Martin, Missoula, MT

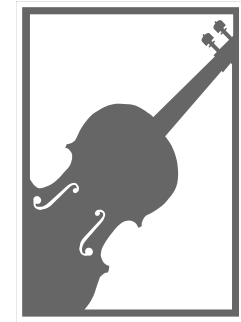

NVMS is a non-profit, community based, music school. Founded in 1997, NVMS currently serves over 700 students annually through private lessons and group offerings.

Workshop and Concert

The workshop begins Saturday, April 10 at 9 am at Whitefish Four Square Church, 233 Kalispell Ave., Whitefish. Pre-Twinkle to Book 1 students will have one repertoire class, a small group class and beginning fiddle (must have mastered Twinkles) Book 2 and above students will have two - 1 hour repertoire classes (current book and previous book.) and a popular music or fiddle class. All students will perform in the final concert at 3:15 pm. Parents are encouraged to attend all classes.

Parent Education Class

Ms. Martin will offer a free parent education class during the workshop. Childcare and art activities will be provided during that time.

Master Classes

There are limited master class slots with Mr. Durbin on Friday afternoon. Classes will be held at NVMS from 3:00 - 7:00. Fee is \$25 (approx 15 min), \$50 for Bk 5 and above (approx 30) minute slot. Free to observers. Please have a short piece or part of a piece ready to play.

Repertoire

The material to be played in the groups and at the concert will be chosen from the repertoire list to the right. The student's most advanced "polished piece" will be used to determine which classes the student will attend. It is recommended that students have the repertoire list up through their "polished piece" reviewed and practiced.
